



iPhone Basics

The iPhone is a simple and powerful smartphone made by Apple. You can use it to make calls, send texts, go online, take pictures, and more. This guide will show you how to use your iPhone, including basic features, settings, and tips to get started.



To make the most of your iPhone or other Apple devices, you'll need an Apple ID. An Apple ID is a free account that gives you access to all of Apple's services, like downloading apps from the App Store, using iCloud to save your photos and files, and buying music or movies. It also helps keep your information secure and allows you to sync data across your Apple devices. Setting up an Apple ID is easy and an important first step to using your iPhone fully.

- Making Calls: Tap the green phone icon to call someone. You can use the keypad or choose a contact from your list.
- **Sending Texts:** Use the blue Messages app to send and receive text messages. Tap the keyboard to type and press send.
- **Taking Photos:** Open the Camera app to take pictures or videos. Just point and tap the button to capture.
- **Going Online:** Use the Safari app to search the internet. Type what you want to find in the search bar.
- **Apps:** Apps are small programs that let you do things like check email, play games, or watch videos. You can find apps on your home screen.
- **Settings:** The Settings app lets you change how your phone works, like adjusting sound, connecting to Wi-Fi, or changing your wallpaper.

Gestures, sometimes called multi-touch gestures, are what you'll use to open apps, navigate the Internet, and more.

- **Tap to click** or select something on the screen, like an app or a link. You can also tap and hold to occasionally access other options (think of this as right-clicking).
- **Drag to scroll up and down**, left and right, or any other direction on the screen.
- Swipe left or right to flip through pages on the Home screen, photos, or pages in an e-book.
- **Double-tap to zoom** in or out on photos, websites, and certain apps.
- Pinch to zoom in or out almost anywhere.
