

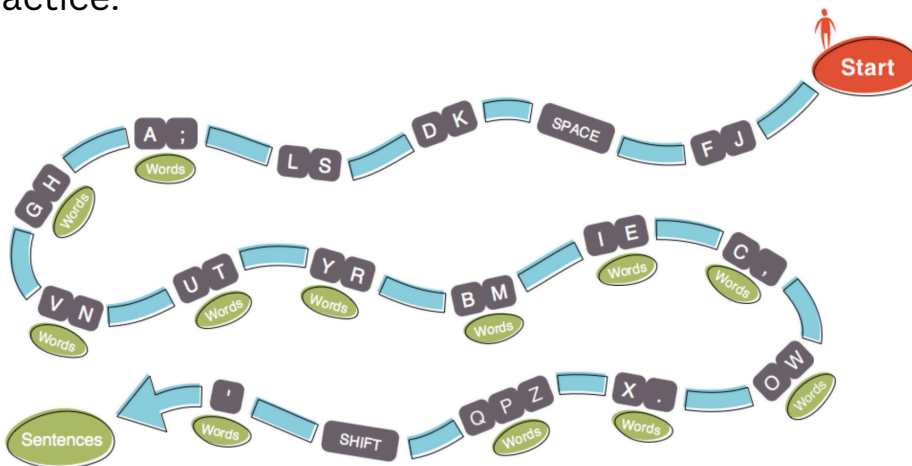
A keyboard is a tool used to type words, give commands, and complete tasks on a computer. This tutorial will show you how to place your hands, type correctly, and use the keyboard for different activities.

Getting Started with Typing

Typing involves using a keyboard to enter letters, numbers, and symbols into a computer. Start by placing your fingers on the *home row keys*: A, S, D, and F for your left hand and J, K, L, and ; for your right hand. Use your thumbs to press the spacebar. Each finger is responsible for specific keys and the more you practice, the easier it gets.
